Expectations for Junior and Youth Teams

- 1. Students are required to attend all team rehearsals from January through March. Any missed rehearsals during this time could result in being moved to another team, or removed from routines.
- 2. Students may miss up to three rehearsals per semester (September to December, and March to May) without penalty. Depending upon the absences and how frequent during these time periods students will not be placed in certain routines or may forfeit their place on the team altogether.
- 3. Students must attend all performances and competitions that are scheduled at the beginning of the year, including the end of year performance.
- 4. Students must be willing to do their best to match their appearances to their peers, including but not limited to: hair styles, tanning, make-up, and dance shoes. List of required items each year will be sent out before the beginning of the season.
- 5. Members of the youth team will participate in monthly team dinners, parents can sign up to host the team.
- 6. Students should, within reason, do their best to refrain from activities where they might injure themselves making them unable to perform or compete with their teammates.
- 7. Students should compete separate from team with a partner.
- 8. Students are required to take a technique class.
- 9. Students are expected to do their best each rehearsal, and work hard for themselves and their teammates.
